


First Look at a TI Graphing Calculator

Objectives:

- Find graphing calculator keys that may not be on your scientific calculator
- Find and use ON and OFF
- Find 2ND key and 2ND functions on keypad

Find graphing calculator keys that may not be on your scientific calculator

Here's an annotated photo of a typical (not-too-fancy) Texas Instruments graphing calculator. All TI calculators have these buttons in these locations.



Find and use ON and OFF

In the lower left corner of the keypad:  turns the calculator on.

On the casing, above the , is OFF. To turn the calculator off, press  .

Find 2ND key and 2ND functions on keypad

Notice what color the letters of OFF are. (Might be blue, green, or other)
This color is above most buttons; these are the 2nd functions you can use from those buttons.

Any time you want to a function that's this color, first press  (located in the upper left), then the key.
